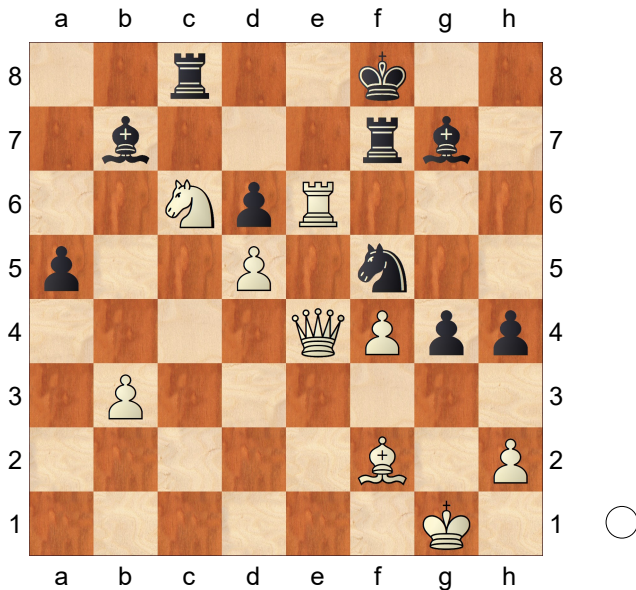

38.Wxd6! Strong move, I am giving up exchange for more direct attack chances. **38...Sxd6 39.Gc5 Wf6?**

After this move, I have much easier way to realize advantage, black had more chances after

[39...Kg8 40.Gxd6 g3 41.Kg2 Gf8 42.Hg6+ Wg7 43.He6+ but anyway at the end position in still lost.]

40.Gxd6+ Wxd6 41.He7+ Kg8
42.Hxd6 Kh7 43.Hd7 Ga6 44.Hf5+
Kh6 45.Hg5+ Kh7 46.Hxh4+ Gh6
47.He7+ Gg7 48.He4+ Kh8 49.d6
